Approximately 1500 words**

CJPH Commentaries are approximately 1500 words in length with a reduced number of references (up to approximately 15) and tables and figures (up to a total combined of 3). Commentaries take a "position" and then bring forth arguments or evidence to support that position.

A text summary is required, up to 200 words in length, giving the reader an idea what the commentary is about.

Also required, 3-6 MeSH terms for indexing purposes. MeSH terms can be found at the following URL: <http://www.nlm.nih.gov/mesh/MBrowser.html>.

When reviewing the enclosed manuscript, you may find it useful to consider the following:

Is it appropriate material for the *CJPH*?

Does it add new information?

Has the author made use of existing knowledge?

What is your recommendation for the manuscript? (Please check one of the following)
