The Canadian Journal of Public Health, under various names, was the impetus for CPHA's founding. First published as the Canadian Journal of Public Health in 1910, then as the Canadian Therapeutist and Sanitary Engineer, then as the Public Health Journal of Canada and then as Public Health Journal (all in 1910). It was renamed Canadian Public Health Journal (1929 to 1942) and then became the Canadian Journal of Public Health (1943 to present).
