# PREVENT

Don't Get A Bull's-Eye!

What is Lyme Disease?

- Disease transmitted through infected blacklegged ticks
- Diagnosed by symptoms
- Treated within weeks of antibiotics
- Can contain other tickborne diseases

Wear White or Face The Bite!

Prevention

- Pesticides
- Insect repellent with deet
- Remove ticks promptly
- Reduce tick habitats
- Know where to find ticks and avoid them
- Treat clothing and wear light colours
- Walk in the center of trails

Symptoms

- Fever
- Headache
- Fatigue
- Skin rash
- Swollen knees
- Muscle, joint, and nerve pain

Wear Tights to Prevent Bites!

Climate Influence

- Longer summers
- Warmer seasons
- Increased breeding time
- Human activities outside increase
- Increased range from ticks to rodents, birds, and deer

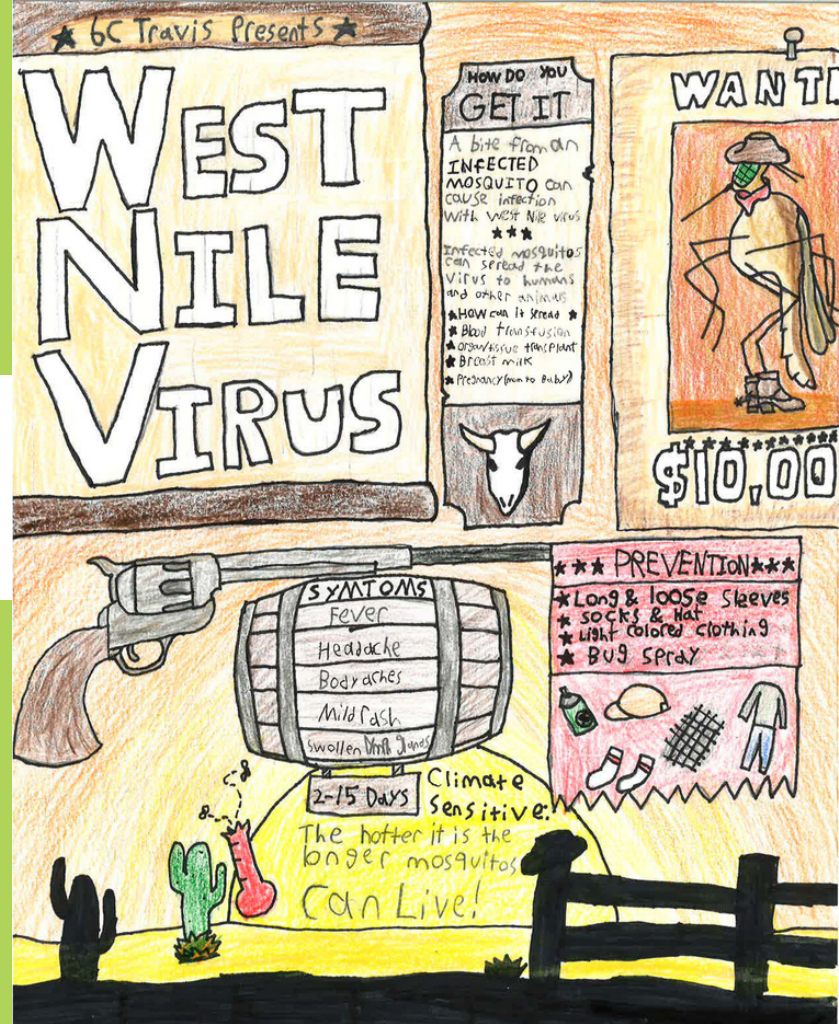
