PREVENT LYME DISEASE

WHAT IS LYME DISEASE?
Lyme disease is a tick-borne disease that is most commonly found in warm areas. The black-legged tick carries this disease.

CLIMATE IS DANGEROUS!
Climate change helps promote tick activity by creating a warm place for them to thrive & reproduce.

SYMPTOMS

- Fever
- Headache
- Fatigue
- Irritation
- Swelling
- Bullseye mark on limbs

HOW TO PREVENT IT

- Avoid tick infested areas
- Wear orange or lavender perfume as ticks hate it
- Wear thick clothing
- Do a tick search when you leave or enter an area
- Wear tick repellent

Tick bites are painless!

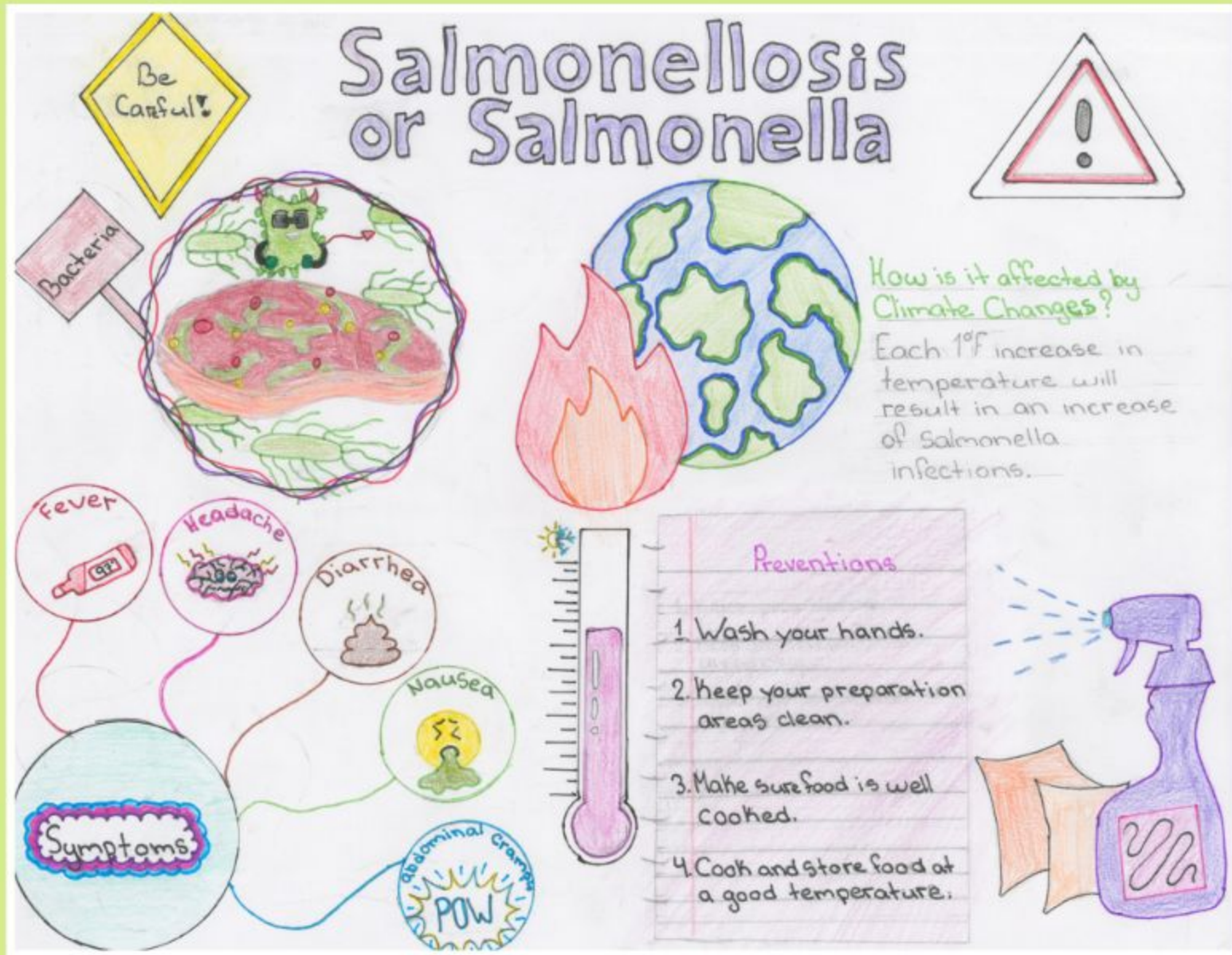
