The Epidemiologist conducts population health assessment and surveillance for Algoma Public Health (APH) through the development, use, and reporting of health and health equity indicators, and the systematic collection, collation, analysis, and dissemination of data to internal and external stakeholders for public health action. As part of the Foundations and Strategic Support Team, the Epidemiologist builds organizational capacity in public health sciences, including the use of data and evidence to inform and evaluate public health interventions toward the goal of improving population health and health equity.

- Master's degree in epidemiology or related discipline and/or combined relevant experience.
- Experience working in a public health setting an asset.
- Ability to conceptualize and manage major epidemiological projects with minimal supervision.
